This letter is to give you information about the recent decisions that have been made regarding Term 1 school holidays in Victoria.

Main points

- Remote Learning Trial day: Mon 23 March (today)
- Term 1 holidays begin: Tue 24 March (tomorrow)
- Current assessment tasks: All due dates are extended until further notice
- Homework: No holiday homework or assessment tasks will be set
- Lockers: Lockers can be accessed Monday & Tuesday
- Term 2 begins: Wed 15 April (to be confirmed)

Extended School Holidays Announcement

Because of the need to prevent groups of people coming together to avoid an increase in infections of Corona virus (COVID-19), the Victorian Premier Daniel Andrews has called for an early finish to Term 1 and a later start to Term 2. This means that your school holidays have been extended and you will not be expected to complete any school work.

Remote Learning Day today

Today's Remote Learning Trial day is going on as planned, so hopefully you are logging in and completing the set lessons according to Monday's timetable.

Do you need to access your locker?

You may have things in your locker that you need over the holidays. Today and tomorrow, Tuesday 24 March, you are allowed to come to school (in casuals) and collect anything you might need over the holidays from your locker.

What about current Assessment Tasks that are due?

If you have an assessment due this week, an extension will be applied until further notice. Next term you will be given new due dates for the work to be submitted. So, don't worry if you haven't done the work yet. You will not be penalised.

However, if you want to finish some tasks that have already been started, then you can submit on-line via SEQTA to your teacher.

Will we get holiday homework?

You will not be given any holiday homework. The holidays start tomorrow and they have been extended until Wednesday April 15 (You will be notified if this date changes).

Thank you everyone and keep supporting the social distancing and personal hygiene recommendations from the government. It is also very important that you don't do things like congregate at shopping centres or other places.
